Council did note the following issues and will fix these up before we return in term 2. Thankyou to our active and responsive Councillor – Peter Cumming.

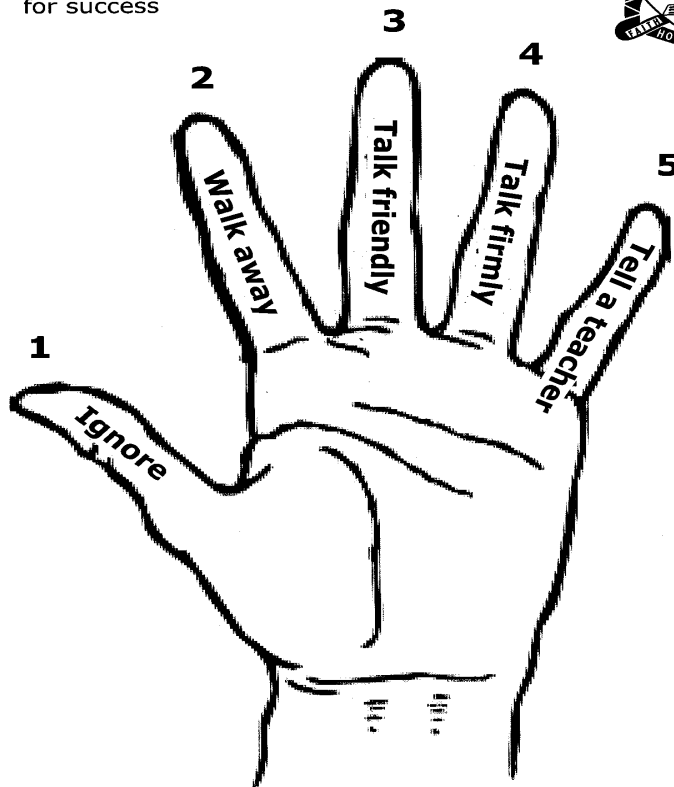
1. Replace Disabled Parking signs
